**READ-A-Thon is January 29 through February 12, 2024**

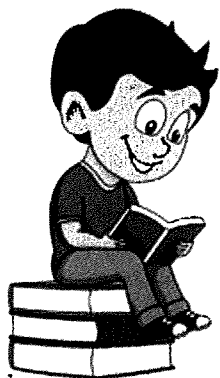
